Accessing Online Textbooks

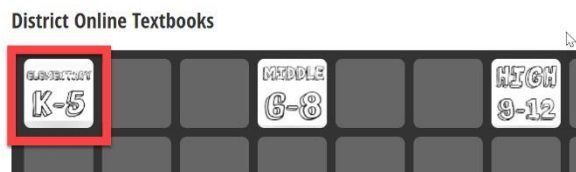
To log into your online textbook resources for math, science, social studies, and iReady follow the directions below.
