Student is required to quarantine and is feeling ill	Student <b>is marked absent</b> and will be provided make-up work upon return to school
Student is required to quarantine due to exposure	Student continues their education and <b>is not marked absent</b> (specific attendance code forthcoming from FDOE)
Assignments and curriculum for quarantined students	<ul> <li>Provide paper-based assignments</li> <li>Provide instructions for completing and submitting work</li> <li>Provide curriculum resources: online textbook access, Raz Kids, Study Island, and iReady</li> </ul>
Check-In Regularly with students at a designated time set by the teacher	<ul> <li>Assist and support families/students via agreed upon mode</li> <li>Answer questions</li> <li>May offer small group instructional time for reading/math at a time set by the teacher.</li> </ul>
*Curriculum Resources	<ul> <li>Books, worksheets for ELA, math, science, social studies</li> <li>Information to access online resources such as iReady, Savvas myView, and Savvas Math</li> </ul>
Preparation for quarantined teacher	In the event teachers are quarantined, PLC/grade level teams should be prepared with lesson plans and materials to assist a substitute.  Materials include:  an instructional packet of hard copy materials  online resources, instructions, and login information for the students.
