School Recognitions Funds Vote- E. McCall

- School Recognition Funds Plans are due to the district by May 15, 2021.
- SAC requested input from all staff members on a draft ballot
- SAC approved the ballot
- The staff voted using the SAC approved ballot.
- Each selection must have 51% of the staff's approval.
- Results of staff vote was shown to SAC for the final approval:
 - 1. 81 Staff Members Voted out of 85 Potential Votes
 - 2. 51% of the potential votes were for both of the top choices.

First Item:

*To be eligible, employees hired during the **2020-2021** school year must meet the full year of service criteria based on the district policy.

o Bonus money will be distributed to the 2020-2021 instructional and non-instructional employees only, regardless of their current

employment status. 51% of potential votes

 Bonus money will be distributed to instructional and non-instructional employees, who were employed at Ocean Palms during the 2020-2021 school year, and will remain during the 2021-2022 school year, with the exception of individuals who have retired.

- I agree to have the funds divided proportionately among all voting members of Ocean Palms Elementary based on the staff member's weekly hours. 45% of potential votes

Review the SAC Survey Data from 2019-2020- N. Reid

- SAC Survey expectations were not required last year due the pandemic.
- The SAC Survey includes two surveys: Staff and Parent Surveys.
- The SAC Faculty Survey shows that the faculty feel that the education offered is consistently high and students feel safe and welcome.
- The SAC Parent Survey shows that parents feel the education offered at our school is high quality and students are safe.
- The parent Survey also shows that 91% of parents feel that school wide communication is effective.
- The Parent Survey also shows that 83% of parents feel that their child has the appropriate amount of homework.

SAC Survey Questions 2020-2021 Vote -E. McCall

- We have district required questions and we are able to write our own questions.
- Our response rate expectations: 20% for parents; 60% for faculty and staff
- The SAC Survey questions helps guide the School Improvement Plan (SIP)
- February 1st February 26th (As a school we voted last meeting to change the survey window.)

Motion to incentivize the completion of SAC Staff Surveys to get 75% completion with chips and other snacks was made by C. Dickson; L. Miller seconded the motion. *Motion Passed*
