- Our response rate expectations set by district is: 20% for parents; 60% for faculty and staff
- 81% of staff completed the Staff Survey
- 42% of the parents completed the Parent Survey

Principal's Update – T. Cantwell

- Laurie Price is the recipient of the Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST). She is only one of two teachers in Florida to win and 1 of 117 teachers in the U.S. to be selected.
- Julie Pantano, OPE Instructional Literacy Coach, shared her experience at the conference with the National Council of Teachers of English.
- Julie Pantano shared how she created a professional development video, featuring an OPE teacher, focusing on a writing lesson that was shared with teachers.
- The recent in-service day provided opportunities for teachers to focus on writing and behavior systems, in addition to the i-Ready training.
- Mrs. Cantwell stated that next year classrooms at our school will not have behavior flip charts or clip up down systems.
- During the i-Ready professional development, the teachers were able to closely look at their i-Ready data and use that data for their Deliberate Practice.
- Facilities Updates from Ms. Cantwell:
 - Required signs, to assist law enforcement, have been hung around the school; every school has the same signage.
 - \circ $\,$ The kitchen resource room and stage will be getting new floors, no waxing is need.
 - Ten portables are being set up in the front field.
 - \circ All of the rooms in the 100 hallway are getting new cubbies and cabinets.
 - Ms. Cantwell presented data and based on equity, requested for an additional Assistant Principal at our school (Dr. Johnson).
- Next year, if we start with 1,000 students our school will receive additional supports, such as two Assistant Principals.
- STEM (Science, Technology, Engendering, and Math) and an additional PE teacher will be the resource teachers we will try to get if we go over 1,000 students at the start of the year.
- March 1st begins Kindergarten Registration.

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• School i-Ready data will be shared at the next SAC meeting. We will look at trend data and comparisons data.

Public Question Period

- With the addition of the new portables, can the helicopter Life Flight still land in the front field? Yes, there will be space and it will still be used in emergency situations.
- Is there a maximum number of portables based on space? Yes, we are limited to 14 portable classrooms on the front field; however, more can be placed in the back field.
- What is the projection for a new school? The newest school that is getting built, will help relieve Freedom Crossing.
- Is rezoning a possibility? To provide answers to questions about growth, Ms. Cantwell will ask Ms. Kelly Barrera to present and share the Power Point that was shared at the School Board Meeting at our next SAC meeting.
- Is there a maximum number of students allowed at OPE? No, we are a public school.
- What are the roles for the Assistant Principals?
 - Dr. Johnson: Focus on Grades PreK -2nd
 - o Ms. Brubaker: Focus on Grades 3-5 and Self-Contained
