#### Principal's Update - T. Cantwell

#### School Improvement Plan (SIP) Review

Our SIP has been submitted to the state for approval. The SIP is a living document that can be amended at any time.

- **School Data:** At our last meeting Mrs. Cantwell shared how our students performed in each testing category in comparison to all elementary schools in the district. The identify of all the schools were anonymous.
  - Celebrations: Strong ELA gains and ELA achievement!
  - Growth Opportunity: Focus on supporting our lowest quartile in Math and ELA and our students with disabilities (SWD) which remains our top priority.

## Student Monitoring System:

- Prior to school year starting we used student data to identify potential students who my need to start the Response to Intervention (RTI) process.
  - We're tracking key metrics (absences, discipline, referrals, and academic history) through our Early Warning System.
  - We brought back our Mentor & Mentee Program with PV High. The group is called Wave Makers
- Our Core Team meets weekly to review student data.
- Grade-level PLCs meet biweekly for data review and collaborative planning.
- All grade levels have access to student data and Core Team notes for deeper peer reviews.
  - To support our teachers with instructional planning we have already provided them with 2 planning days, and they will have a 3<sup>rd</sup> one scheduled in January.
- A 30-minute intervention block is built into the master schedule for all grade levels.
  - It is important to note that the intervention block in grades 4 and 5 is shorter by 5 minutes because these grade levels departmentalize.
  - Current Obstacle with RTI are the limited approved intervention resources in the areas of math and language. This is something that is being addressed with the district.

## Revised Positive Behavior Recognitions:

- Based on student, parent, and teacher input from last year we revised some of our positive recognition programs:
  - Increased acknowledgments for positive behaviors and opportunities to visit the school store – The Otter Outpost.
  - Increased the opportunity to earn character counts awards.
  - Unified the class compliment system to ensure consistent rewards across all classrooms with a "100 Chart" for class compliments.
  - o Based on student input, we refreshed our school store to reflect their preferences.
  - We've added new incentives for Sunshine State Readers to encourage a love for books! Students will receive a large flashing paw to wear around their necks.
