Students will have the opportunity to place their donations on their grade level's table in the main hallway. The grade level with the most donations will win a popcorn party!


All non-perishable food is welcome, but here are some suggestions:

### The Seawalk Pavillion - Jacksonville Beach November 21<sup>st</sup> thru January 2<sup>nd</sup>

Our fifth grade Ambassadors are working hard again this year collecting and painting recyclable items to complete their 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Beaches Go Green Recycled Light Up Art Installation for Deck the Chairs.

For 2020, our Ambassadors are combining the art portion of their 7<sup>th</sup> annual "Thank You First Responders" project, which takes place in January, with Deck the Chairs to create an extravaganza of red, white and blue for this very "green" installation. This year's art portion of the project honoring our First Responders will be the biggest and brightest yet!

The Ambassadors wish to thank the talented *Lauren Rodriguez*, art teacher, and *Isil Sareyyupoglu*, parent artist, for designing our firefighter otter and police officer otter; as well as *Chris Chaney*, PTO President, and maintenance manager, *Mike Marimpietri*, for their carpentry skills. Staff members who serve as mentors to the Ambassadors will finish construction on the build and install the lights on site at Deck the Chairs. The project will also be storm proofed on site in order (*fingers crossed*) to survive the winter weather at the beach.



Please note, only the **Parent or Legal Guardian** of the student can register for a HAC account and the student must be in compliance with Immunizations and Registration requirements as per District Policy. Only one account is needed per family.



### PAINT THE OTTER ROCKS!



For a reservation of \$30, congratulate your favorite student, wish them a happy birthday (or "half" birthday), show appreciation to your favorite teacher or staff member, or just let everyone know how much you love Ocean Palms Elementary School!

#### HOW DO I SIGN UP?

All reservations are made online via the SignUp Genius link. *Please select carefully as we have two rocks available - one at the Bus Loop and one at the Car Loop.* Some school dates are not listed as the rocks will be decorated for school events. Payment can be made through SignUp Genius or by sending in a check to Ocean Palms Elementary PTO. Please keep in mind that your date is not confirmed unless we have received your payment.

Reservations are processed on a first come, first serve basis. The earlier you make your reservation, the more likely you are to secure your desired date(s). Additionally, remember that there are approximately 180 school days per year, and that OPE has over 600 students registered. Please understand if the date you requested is unavailable.

#### WHEN CAN I PAINT THE ROCKS?

You may paint your designated rock from 3:30-6pm on the day you have reserved. When booking your date please keep in mind the day that you paint will be the day before the event you're celebrating. For example, if your child's birthday is Tuesday, September 22, then you would reserve Monday, September 21<sup>st</sup> to paint. If you would like your message visible on a Monday, you would need to paint on Friday.

#### ARE THERE ANY RESTRICTIONS ON DECORATIONS?

What is painted on an Otter Rock MUST be in good taste and MAY NOT contain any foul language, discriminatory, religious, and/or political statements/symbols. Profanity and obscenities are not permitted. You may only promote a business if they are a Corporate Partner with OPE.

Character Counts here in St. Johns County. All messages should be affirming! Designs should have a caring and nurturing message. All wording and symbols must be positive.

### WHAT SUPPLIES DO I NEED TO PAINT THE ROCK?

You may use spray paint or regular paint – it's up to you! You will need to use your own paint brushes. Painting tip: Bring a piece of chalk to write any letters/words before painting! An Otter Rock Borrow Bin is available in the school building with a selection of paint. Help yourself to what's in the bin or feel free to donate any leftover paint you may have for the next person. You will be able to enter the school and the employee at the Front Desk will be able to retrieve it for you. We recommend purchasing spray paint to do a base coat and then paint for the letters and details.

Families, groups or organizations must furnish their own labor, paint and supplies to paint a rock. Any paintbrushes used must be washed at home.

ONLY the rock can be painted. Painting on sidewalks, driveways, fences, etc. is prohibited. Any damage or destruction to the surrounding areas or buildings will deem the family, group or organization financially responsible for cleaning and repair costs. This means that ALL PAINT SUPPLIES MUST STAY NEAR THE OTTER ROCKS. We recommend using plastic drop cloths to protect the mulch, stones, driveway and curb while you are painting.

Bring a large trash bag to take home all items/supplies after the painting is complete. You will not have access to water on site to rinse off brushes. You will need to properly discard all painting supplies at home and not on school grounds. Used paint cans are not to be placed in campus trash bins or dumpsters. Please dispose of paint cans properly off campus.

#### WHAT IF IT'S RAINING WHEN IT'S TIME FOR ME TO PAINT?

There will be no refunds, even due to the weather. Unfortunately you may have to hold an umbrella if it is raining. If you are unable to paint the rock on schedule according to your reservation (due to a conflict in your schedule, forgetfulness, weather, school closure, etc.), please contact Stephanie Marciani (<a href="mailto:shmorse@yahoo.com">shmorse@yahoo.com</a>) to see about switching to a new date. Please MARK YOUR CALENDAR!
