

How Do I Get Approved to Access the School Building?

In an ongoing endeavor to provide safety and security for students and staff, school access is required for every individual that is not a staff member of the St. Johns County School District. Below are the steps every visitor must complete to access the building during school hours.

1. **Complete the School Access Form at <https://stjohns.keepntrack.com/apply>. Do not wait to complete your application because the process can potentially take up to two weeks to clear.**



SCHOOL ACCESS

FILL OUT YOUR VOLUNTEER SCHOOL ACCESS FORM!

In a continuing effort to provide safety and security to our students and staff we ask that you complete a **School Access Form** if you plan to enter a facility in the St. Johns County School District. Any person passing beyond the front office area must show a valid driver's license or state identification card.

It is recommended individuals include their **middle name** when completing the online application; and, if no middle name, then please use the acronym "NMN".

2. Bring your ID when you check in at the front office.

- Proper identification must be presented each time a person signs in at a school. The only forms of proper identification are the following:
 - Current state issued driver's license
 - Current state issued identification card (issued only by the DMV)
- If a person has a visa and/or does not have a social security number, the applicant must contact the Volunteer Services department (547-3952) right away for alternate steps.
- School access lasts for 3 year intervals. Upon approaching 3 years of access, it is the responsibility of the applicant to contact Volunteer Services and renew the form. To reduce duplication, do not complete a new form.

What is Kindergarten Staggered Start?

Staggered Start provides an opportunity for the kindergarten teacher to work with a small group of students each day to teach rituals and routines and ensure students are comfortable with their environment before introducing them to the entire class.

How does this work?

On Tuesday, August 9, at Meet the Teacher Kindergarten families will select one day between Wednesday through Friday to attend school.

- ⇒ **Wednesday, 8/10/22 - Dismissal 1:45**
- ⇒ **Thursday 8/11/22 - Dismissal 2:45**
- ⇒ **Friday, 8/12/22 - Dismissal 2:45**

Staggered Start Drop Off

We are asking parents of kindergarten students who wish to walk their child to class during staggered start to complete the visitor access application (see p.2) and arrive at school between (8:40-9:00) on their designated day for check in. Please bring your photo ID.



Lunch Accounts

Prepayments to your child's meal account with a debit or credit card can be made through Paypams. Log on to <https://paypams.com/> to set up your account. Payment can also be received by the food service manager in form of check or cash during your child's lunch time. If a check is used, please indicate the student's full name on the check in the memo section. Prepayment is encouraged as it assists in movement of students through the line. 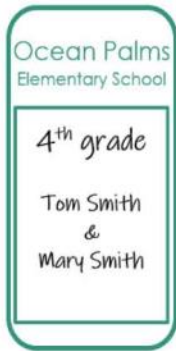

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL



Car Tags Required

All parents will be given car tags to be displayed during Parent Pick-Up (PPU). Please hang or place the tag where it can be easily seen from a distance. We ask that you print the grade level (of the youngest student if siblings) at the top and the student's name(s) underneath. Please see the example on the left.

Older siblings will wait with younger siblings in the younger sibling's grade level area during dismissal. For safety, students may only enter the car on the passenger side of the vehicle.

All Car Rider Traffic

When entering and leaving the parking lot at Ocean Palms please be aware of oncoming traffic and pedestrians. If you are arriving to pick-up a student from the PreK area and the line is backed-up onto Landrum Lane, we ask that you adhere to department of transportation traffic laws and wait in the line until it is safe to use the entrance correctly. **Do not use the exit lane for any reason to enter the parking lot.**

Arrival Procedures

Parents and guardians, for the safety of our children, staff, and visitors, please be patient, do not pass cars, use our entrance traffic lanes, and refrain from the use of cell phones unless using Bluetooth during parent drop off and pick up.

School supervision of students begins at 8:00 a.m. Students who arrive **before** 8:00 a.m. must be enrolled in the Ocean Palms before-care program unless they are participating in a club event. When using the parent drop off and pick up lanes, we ask that adults stay in their vehicle. For safety students must exit the vehicle on the right (sidewalk) side of the vehicle.

PreK and ESE students shall be dropped off at the front of the car line starting at 8:00. **Please place your child's car seat on the passenger (sidewalk) side of your vehicle. Ensure that you have your Parent Pick-up (PPU) tag hanging from your rear-view mirror. Staff members will be looking for your PPU tag to know which vehicles have students who require assistance.** PreK and ESE students will be met by staff members and escorted to the classroom.

Dismissal / Transportation Changes

All students will receive a luggage tag for their backpacks that designate their mode of dismissal. If you need to make a transportation change for your child, please send a written note to your child's teacher that morning. **In the event a note could not be sent, please call the front office (547-3760) before 12:15 p.m.** Be sure to complete up to five emergency contacts who are permitted to pick up your child. We apologize for any inconvenience, but the safety of our children is our number one priority.

PreK Dismissal 2:30 and 1:30 on Wednesdays

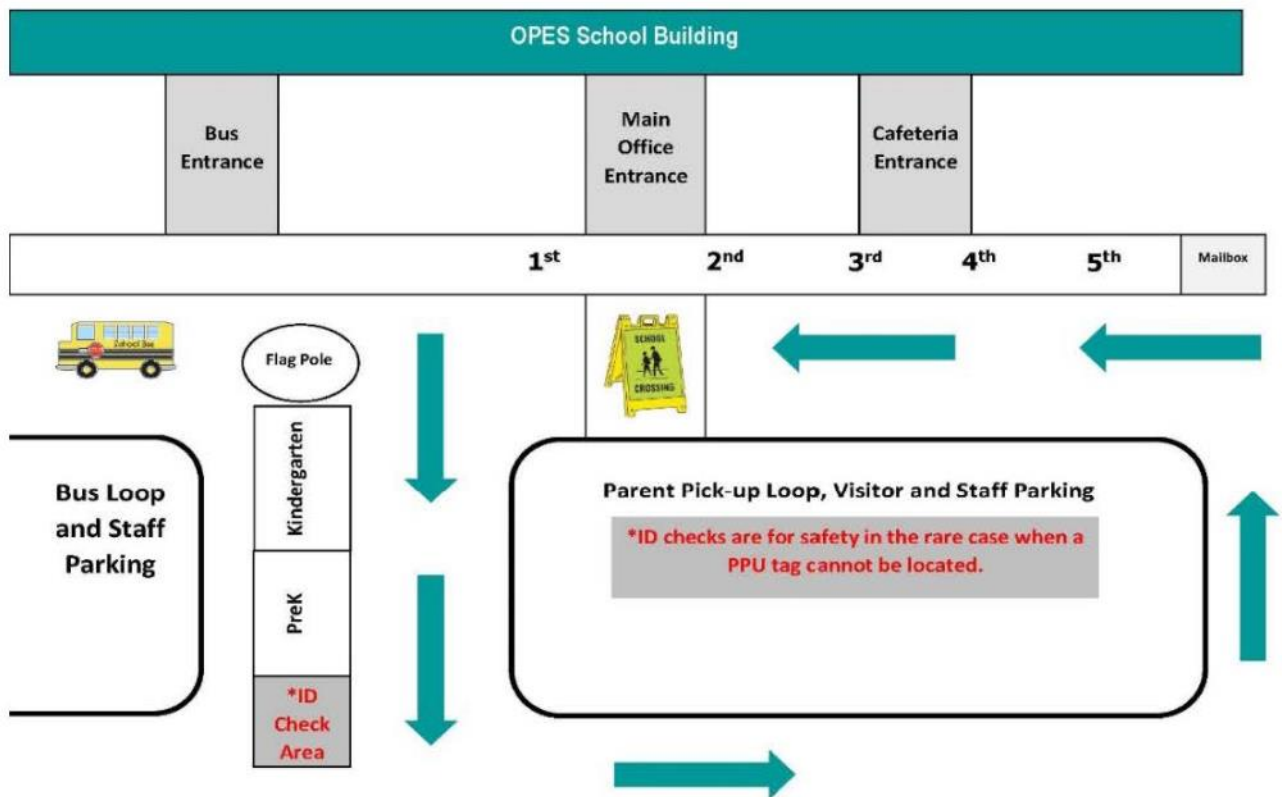
PreK students will be picked-up at the front of the line starting at 2:30. Students will be waiting with teachers and paraprofessionals. Please remain in your vehicle. A staff member will assist your child into their car seat. After your child has entered the vehicle and the door is closed, please pull into a parking space if you need to adjust the car seat straps or seatbelt. Older siblings will join PreK students in their designated pick up area.

PreK parents arriving late will not be permitted to skip to the front of the car line once K-5 dismissal has started. Anyone bypassing the carline for pick up will be asked to park and walk across the crosswalk to pick up their child in the front office.

(K-5) Dismissal 2:45 and 1:45 on Wednesdays

(K-5) parents are asked to remain behind the cones in the car line until the PreK PPU dismissal is complete. (K-5) students utilizing PPU line will be picked up starting at 2:45. The passenger back door of your vehicle will be opened for your child. Please remain in your vehicle and have your car tag visible. Once your child is safely in the vehicle, please slowly merge into the left lane to exit the parking lot.

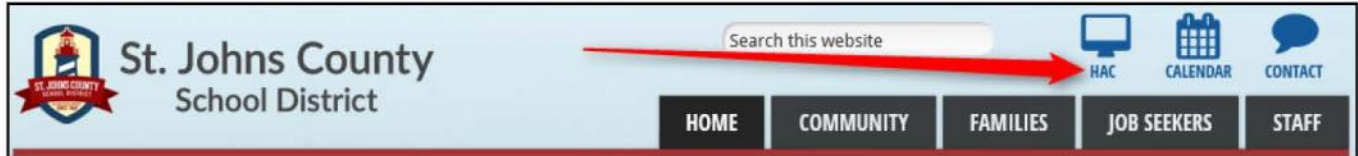

Parents: New Home Access Center Account "HAC"

To register for a Home Access Center Account, "HAC", please follow the below instructions. Please note, only the **Parent or Legal Guardian** of the student can register for a HAC account and the student must be in compliance with Immunizations and Registration requirements as per District Policy. Only one account is needed per family.

Navigate to the St. Johns County School District website at <http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/>. Across the top of the homepage, you will see the HAC Icon. Click to enter HAC.



On this page you will find an overview of the Home Access Center, FAQ's and the log in prompt. To login, click the blue "Login to Home Access Center" box.



If you already have an account, you can log in using your user name and password. If you need to register for a HAC account, "Click here to register for HAC".

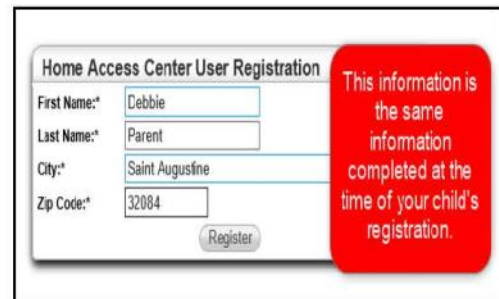


Fill in all fields completely:

First Name and Last Name: Enter the information that was given at the time of your child's registration. If your first name is Elizabeth and you wrote down "Liz", use "Liz".

City: Be sure to completely spell out the City such as "Saint Augustine", "Saint Johns", "Hastings", etc. (Do not abbreviate)

Zip Code: Use the 5 digit Zip code for your home address



After entering the above information, select the "Register" button

Once your account has been located, please create a user name. It is recommended that you **use your current email address as your user name**. Next, create challenge questions and answers, finally click "finish". Your account is now ready for use.



The St. Johns County School District (SJCSJ) has recently implemented the eSchoolPLUS Family Mobile App for parents/guardians. This mobile app allows parents to see many of the Home Access Center (HAC) features from their mobile phone. This application uses the same login credentials as Home Access Center (HAC).

Here is what the eSchoolPLUS Family app looks like in the app store (Apple or Google):

Here are some of the key academic areas displayed by this mobile app:

- Transportation

In addition, we discovered that some parents were using other untrusted 3rd party mobile apps to provide similar data pulled from our system by providing them with their personal HAC credentials. This can be dangerous because, the District has no connection or affiliation with these other vendor apps. By providing them with your credentials, you have granted them access to your child's personal academic data. If this is the case, we recommend you remove the 3rd party app from your phone and then change your password in HAC. Then download and use the new eSchoolPLUS Family app (shown above).

School Messenger

School Messenger is a rapid phone, text, and/or email notification system provided by our school district to communicate information efficiently. This system will be used for providing information to parents and guardians about safety, attendance, and school events. Please visit <https://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/schoolmessenger/> for detailed information.

How to Opt-in or Opt-out of SchoolMessenger Text Messages

The first step of the process was conducted on 1/4/17 when the District sent an opt-in text message to all parent/guardian and staff phone numbers on file. If you received the opt-in message on your mobile device and responded with a "Y" or "Yes", you should have received a confirmation text message stating, "You're registered 4 SchoolMessenger notifications". No further action is required for you to receive future text messages from your child's school or from the District.

If you **did not** receive the opt-in message on your mobile device and want to receive text messages from your child's school or from the District please follow the steps below:

1. From your mobile device, **Text "Yes" to 67587**. You should then receive a response text message stating, "You're registered 4 SchoolMessenger notifications".
2. Now that you have registered your device to receive text messages, you must verify that your mobile device phone number(s) is on file at your child's school.
 - You can verify that your contact phone numbers are up to date by viewing them in SchoolMessenger InfoCenter.
 - If you need to make changes to the phone numbers listed, please contact your child's school.

If you wish to opt-out of text messaging, simply text "Stop" to 67587.

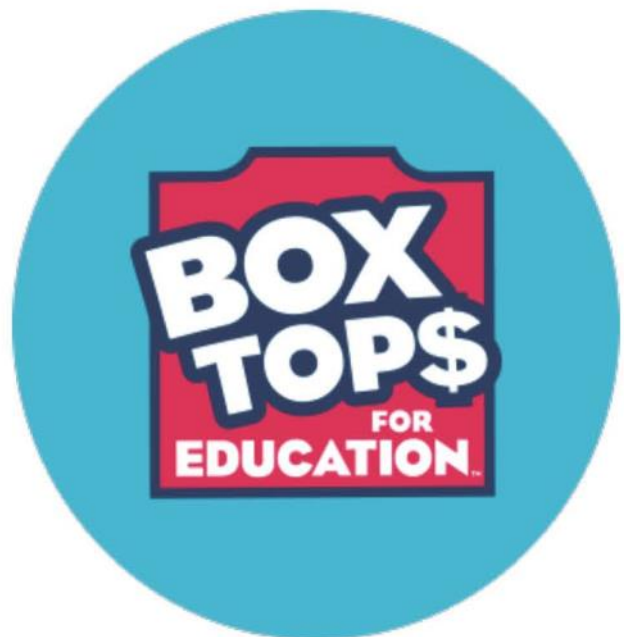

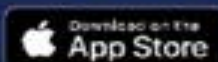
