Dear Elementary School Parents/Guardians:

I'm writing to share the annual required instruction information, per State Board Rule. All students in grades kindergarten through 12 are to receive instruction related to youth substance use and abuse health education and child trafficking prevention and awareness (Rule 6A-1.094124, F.A.C).

These are important topics that will help our students have the knowledge and ability to act when faced with difficult situations. I believe this instruction will be extremely beneficial for your children and/or reinforce what is taught at home.

School counselors and classroom teachers will lead the instruction and discussions on substance use and abuse health education. Only school counselors will lead the instruction and discussion on child trafficking.

I am proud of the work district staff has done to select and develop instructional materials that are age appropriate. This is statutorily required instruction and there is no opt out opportunity for students.
