We are now several weeks into the school year, and it has been wonderful to watch our otter raft settling into strong routines and joyful learning. Children thrive on rituals and consistency, and these early weeks are the perfect time to establish habits that set the tone for the entire year. From morning greetings to classroom expectations, these daily rhythms give students a sense of comfort and belonging, while also opening the door for them to take on new challenges with confidence.

One of the most powerful rituals you can create at home is reading with your child. Whether it's a bedtime story, reading aloud together, or enjoying a quiet time side-by-side with books, these moments build vocabulary, strengthen comprehension, and spark imagination. At school, students have the opportunity to take A.R. quizzes to earn points and prizes for their independent reading. Ask your child what book they're reading now you might be surprised how excited they are to share!

We also love celebrating positive choices and character. At Ocean Palms, students earn Positive PAWS when they demonstrate the pillars of character. Each week, one student from every classroom is drawn to visit our school store, the Otter Outpost. The more PAWS a student earns, the better their chances! In addition, students are working together to earn compliments for teamwork, listening, and following expectations. Once a class reaches 100 compliments, they receive a special reward. We are only in the third week of school and already have classes with more than 40 compliments. That's a lot of teamwork to celebrate!
